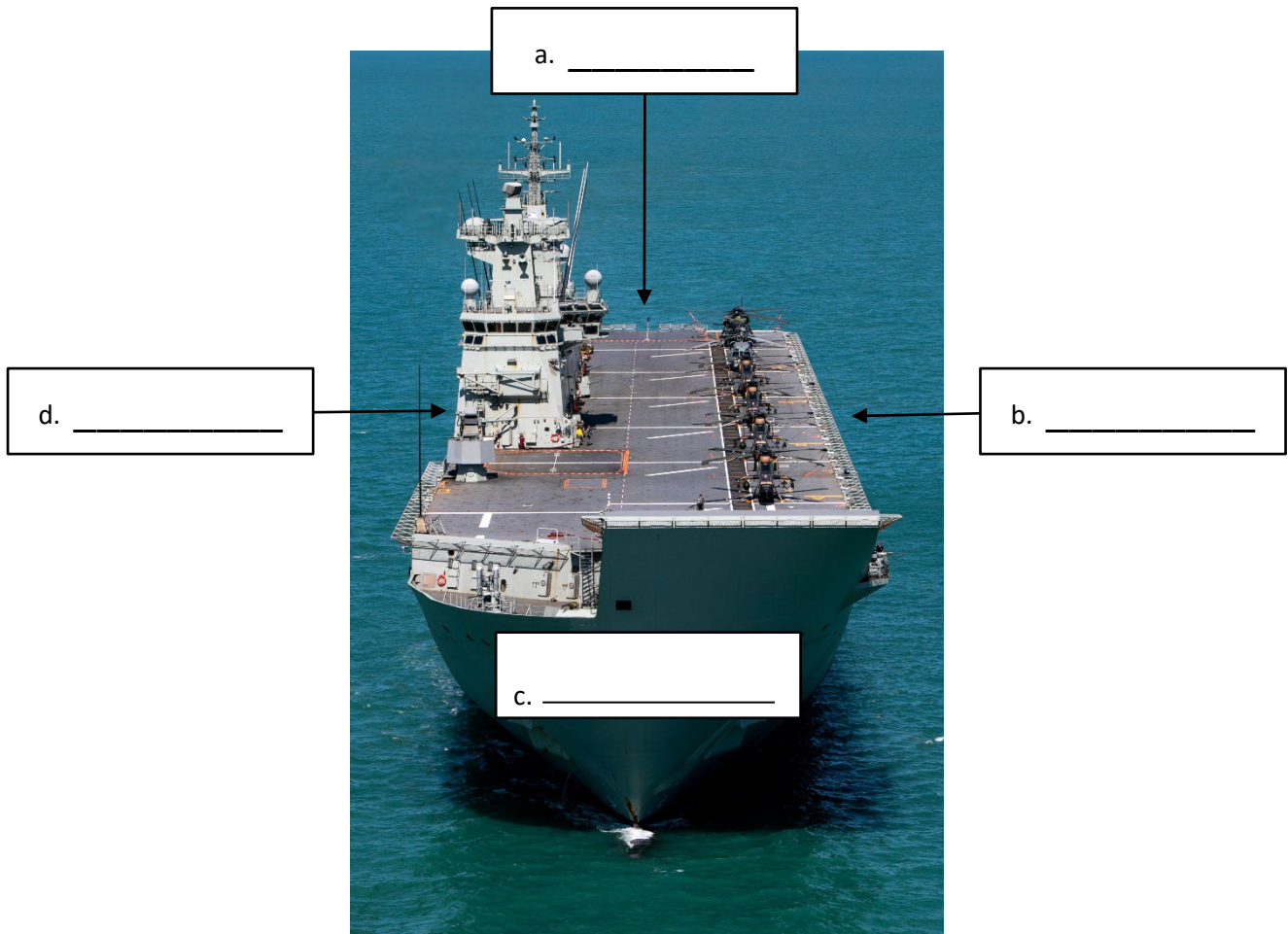

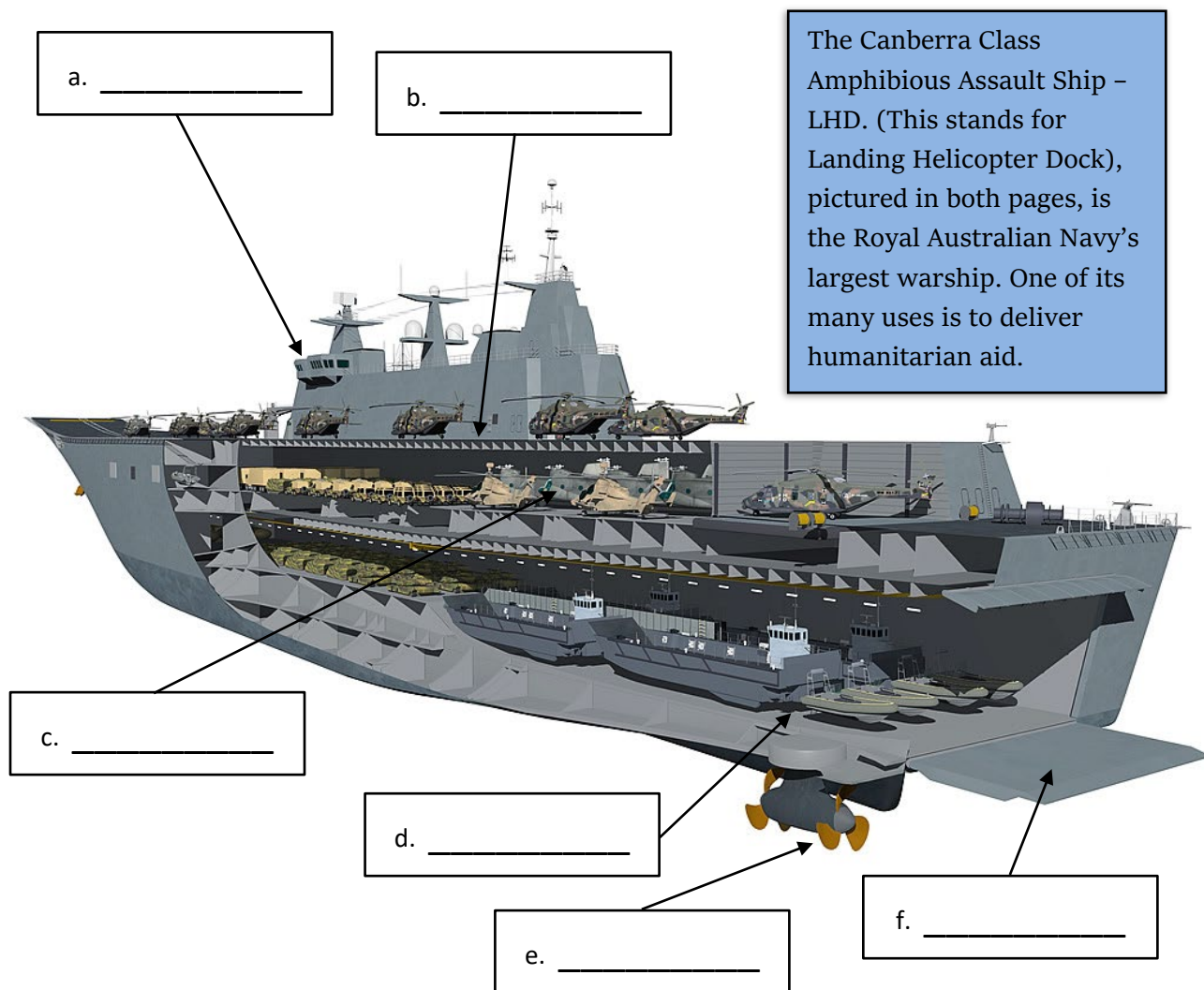

2) Now let's learn the parts of an amphibious assault ship. Match the words in the box to each part.



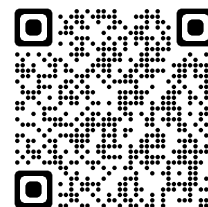
