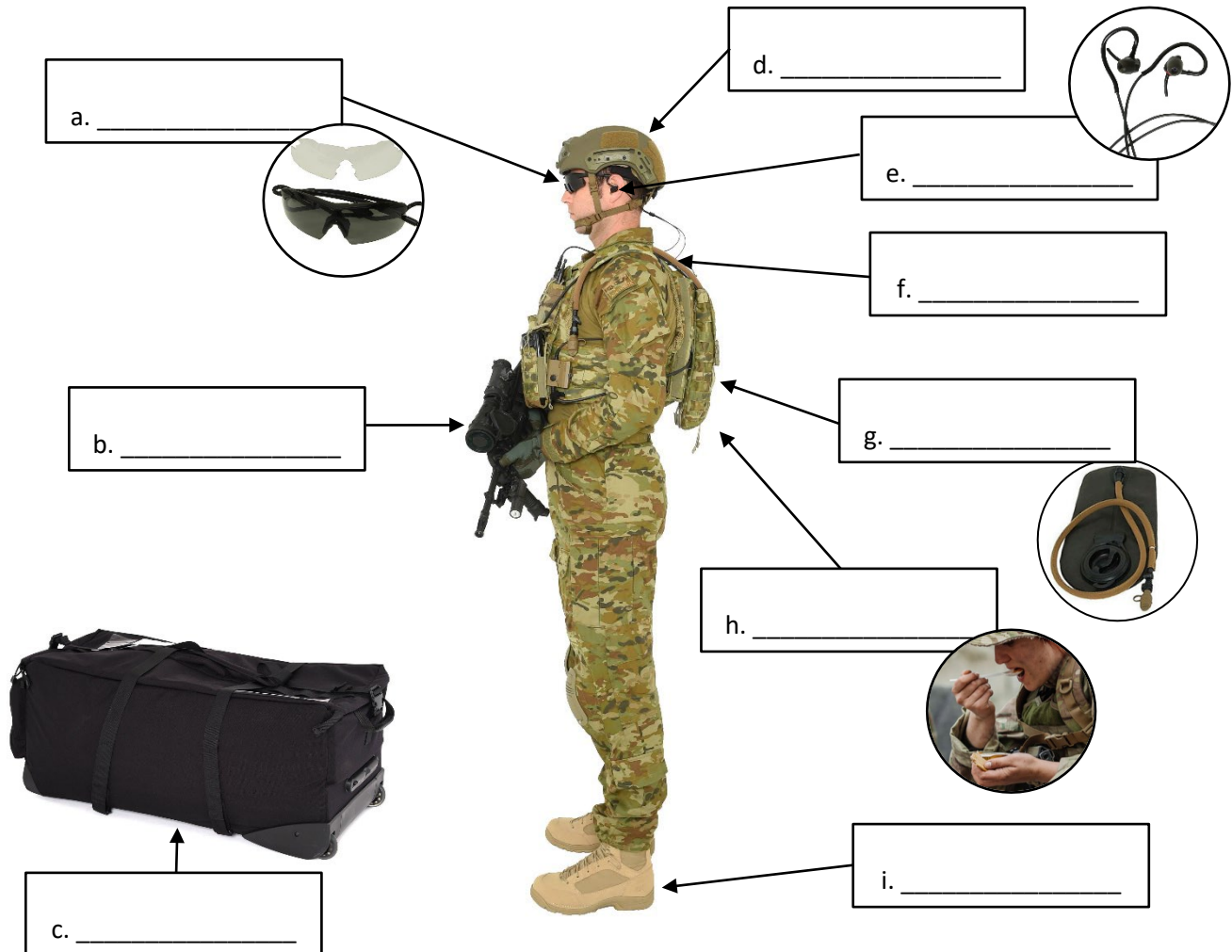
### Overview:
