Vocabulary Builder: Parts of an Aircraft

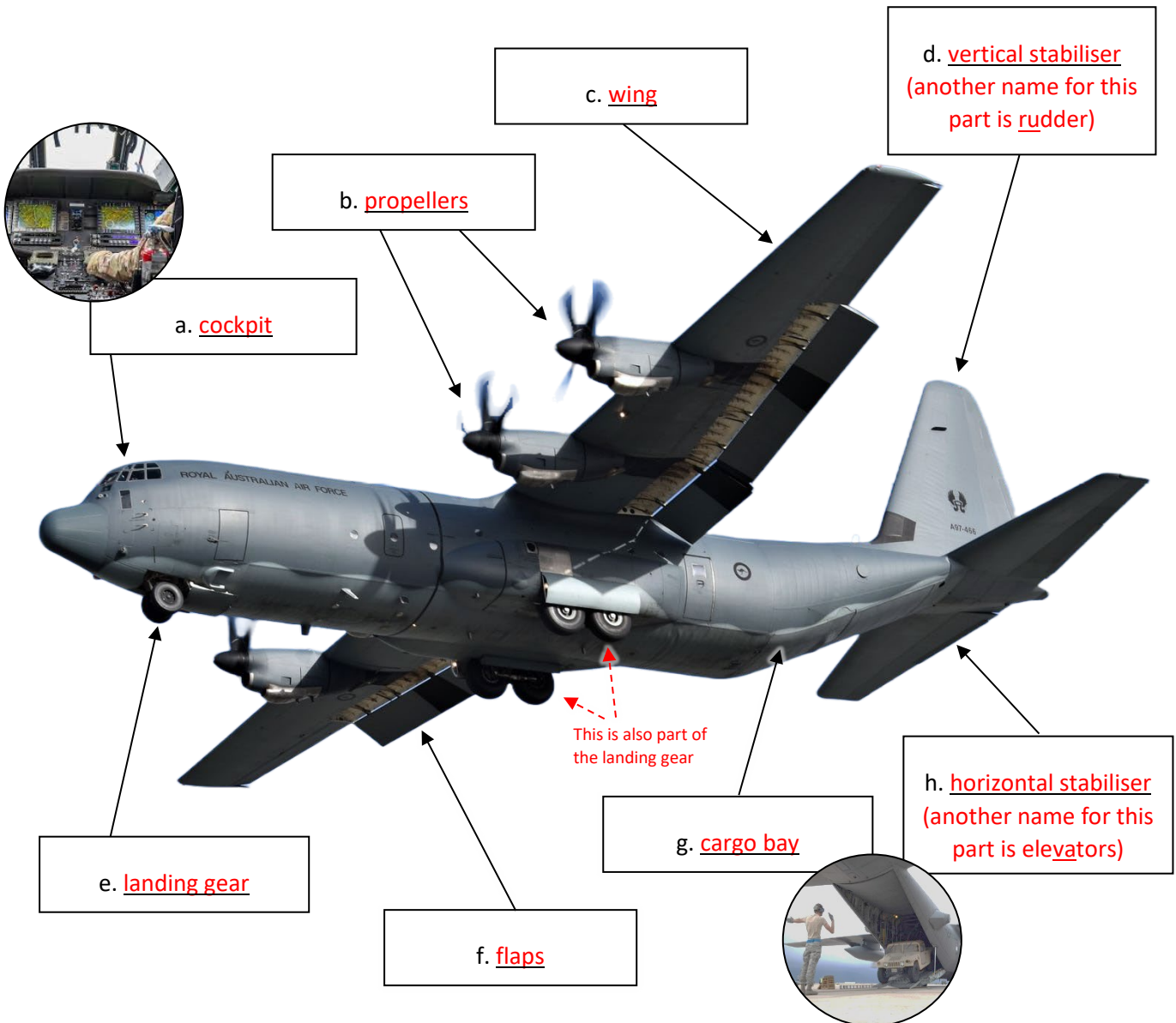
Overview:
